Advisor: Dr. Philip Taylor Performing Arts Education and Therapy: Investigating the Scope of Interest for a New Journal Publication

This research study was devised with the hope of creating a new journal that engages dialogue across the arts education disciplines and the related arts therapies. My work consisted of creating a literature review encompassing as many published journals in arts, arts education, and arts therapies as possible. The document created from the study was then circulated to over one hundred arts educators, therapists, and theorists for review and was later included as reference material for the Forum on Arts Assessment at New York University in August, 2003. The literature review and subsequent Forum on Arts Assessment led to the creation of Arts Praxis, a new scholarly journal on Arts Education and the related Arts Therapies, published annually by the Program in Educational Theatre at New York University.
