ii. Faculty development grants- the committee agreed that it would like to request full transparency regarding the grant, more specifically as to who got funded, where was the money allocated, how much funds are available and finally, who makes the final decision on the grant and how it is determined. The committee that spends long hours reviewing the grants would like to retain the authority of the decision of awarding the grants and how the budget is allocated moving forward. The committee also stressed the importance of involving and including the adjuncts in the event.
