QUESTIONS ABOUT THE FLEXIBLE GRADING POLICY?

For Fall 2020, BMCC has decided to continue a version of the Flexible Grading Policy and allow students to opt into CR/NC for their courses, with the exception of EMC-, HIT-, NUR- and RTT- designated courses. In addition students who earn grades of A and A- cannot opt to change their grades to CR. We strongly encourage you to speak with an academic or faculty advisor before you decide.

GRADES	COURSE POINTS	WHAT SHOULD I DO?
B+, B, B-, C+, C	These grades are equivalent to 2.0 and above.	These are passing grades, so I would speak with my advisor before changing them to "CR."
C-, D+, D, D-	These grades are below 2.0.	While these are passing grades, I would change some or all of them to "CR" but I would speak with my advisor first.
F	This grade is equivalent to zero.	*This is not a good grade! I would change it immediately to "NC." The "NC" grade will not affect your GPA.
INC	The Incomplete grade does not have any course points.	I would complete my coursework, get my grade and then refer to the recommendations above.
