INSTITUTIONAL PRIORITIES

- INCREASE ENROLLMENT by enhancing admissions and advising and addressing retention and transfer barriers
- IMPROVE ALIGNMENT between academic programming, student demand, and workforce needs through program review, enhancement of online offerings, and expansion of short-term programs
- REDUCE EQUITY GAPS through greater support for culturally responsive and sustaining pedagogy and expansion of comprehensive academic and basic needs assistance
- EXPAND ACCESS to comprehensive academic and student supports that are associated with greater student outcomes
- CULTIVATE CAREER PREPARATION, exploration, and development opportunities for credit and non-credit student populations
- ENGAGE AND PARTNER with corporate and philanthropic partners to support academic programming, strengthen career development, and grow financial resources

INCREASE ENROLLMENT

- Enrollment Update (headcount as of 9/02/2022)
 - Fall 2022: 17,137 (-8.9% from prior year)
 - New 3,805 (-1.8% from prior year)
 - Transfers 1,291 (+12.4% from prior year)
 - Readmits 1,403 (-21.6% from prior year)
 - Non-Degree 984 (+13.6% from prior year)
 - Continuing 9,654 (-13.9% from prior year)
- Express registration ongoing
 - 7W1 session = 866
 - 8W2 session = 1875

INCREASE ENROLLMENT

- BMCC Return Rate:
 Percent of Students Returning the Following Full Term
- Continuing Enrollment Plan for Spring 2023
 - Increasing Fall to Spring Return Rate (>67%)
 - Spring 2023 Goal: 12,000 Students
- Continuing Enrollment Plan for Fall 2023
 - Increasing Fall to Fall Return Rate (>49.5%)
 - Fall 2023: 8,910 Students

- Strategic Enrollment Management
 - Focus on retention initiatives
 - Tutoring, SI, student intervention (Starfish)

- EVC and University Provost Hensel, BMCC Listening Tour and Town Hall Meeting, November 7, 2022
- BMCC Foundation I Gala, October 27, 6-10 pm @ Tribeca 360. Brian Ruane/BNY Mellon is Leadership Honoree; Sandra Lindsay, Award of Excellence Honoree. So far more than \$750K raised
- ACCT Leadership Congress will take place October 26-28 in NYC. Members will tour BMCC October 26 from 10 am to 1:30 pm
- BMCC students will visit **Morehouse College October 4-6**, **2022** as a part of the **BMCC-Morehouse Articulation Initiative**
- **BMCC CUNY in the HEIGHTS** hosted a Telethon for Hurricane Fiona disaster relief September 26, 2022 in partnership with the Hispanic Federation to benefit affected people in the Dominican Republic

- Amazon Go & Amazon Fresh donated fresh and shelf-stable food as well as a new industrial refrigerator to the Panther Pantry to provide more of our students in need with healthy food options
- BMCC and BMCC Black Faculty Association hosted Black EdFluencers-United (BE-U) September 14, 2022. Speakers included President Anthony Munroe, NYCDOE Chancellor David Banks, Dr. Patterson/My Brothers Keeper, Deputy Mayor Sheena Wright, Dr. Blake/President, BE-U, Prof. James Blake
- The Gabarron Foundation partnered with BMCC for a moving program on 9/11.
 International artist Don Cristobal Gabarron completed a live painting while faculty and student artists performed at this event attended by college, local, regional, and international guests

- Moody's has contributed \$100,000 to support 20 full scholarships
- Moody's Black Impact Group (B.I.G.) is hosting an event Tuesday, October 18th at 7 World Trade Center, 19th Floor for students to interact with Moody's employees who will share their DEI journey and the importance of fostering a diverse and inclusive workplace
- Moody's has expanded their mentoring program to 15 students
- BNY Mellon now has 41 students in their STARTUP Program and has hired
 5 students
