B. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR SENIOR COLLEGE PROGRAM

Applicants to the La Salle University RN to BSN online program must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 in prior nursing program.

The following documents should be submitted as part of the application:

- Official transcripts from all colleges, universities and/or nursing schools previously attended or attending
- RN license number and state

Before beginning nursing major courses, students must have earned at least 67 liberal arts credits, all transferable into the program from BMCC or other Universities. Please note, as the Nursing program at BMCC has a 65-credit total, students transferring to La Salle University under this agreement will need to complete a minimum of 2 additional credits in order to enter the RN to BSN program in Nursing.

College credit may be granted for prerequisite courses at La Salle University, as well as through CLEP, and Excelsior College examinations.

F. ARTICULATION AGREEMENT FOLLOW-UP PROCEDURES

- *Procedures for reviewing, updating, modifying or terminating agreement:*
When either of the degree programs involved in this agreement undergoes a change, the agreement will be reviewed and revised accordingly by faculty from each institution’s respective departments, selected by their Chairpersons.
- *Procedures for evaluating agreement, i.e., tracking the number of students who transfer under the articulation agreement and their success:*
Each semester, La Salle University will provide BMCC with the following information: a) the number of BMCC students who applied to the program; b) the number of BMCC students who were accepted into the program; c) the number of BMCC students who enrolled and; d) the aggregate GPA of these enrolled students.
- *Sending and receiving college procedures for publicizing agreement, e.g., college catalogs, transfer advisers, websites, etc.:*
This articulation agreement will be published on the BMCC website and La Salle University website. Transfer advisors and program directors at the BMCC will promote this agreement with eligible students.
