INSTITUTIONAL PRIORITIES

- INCREASE ENROLLMENT by enhancing admissions and advising and addressing retention and transfer barriers
- IMPROVE ALIGNMENT between academic programming, student demand, and workforce needs through program review, enhancement of online offerings, and expansion of short-term programs
- **REDUCE EQUITY GAPS** through greater support for culturally responsive and sustaining pedagogy and expansion of comprehensive academic and basic needs assistance
- EXPAND ACCESS to comprehensive academic and student supports that are associated with greater student outcomes
- CULTIVATE CAREER PREPARATION, exploration, and development opportunities for credit and non-credit student populations
- ENGAGE AND PARTNER with corporate and philanthropic partners to support academic programming, strengthen career development, and grow financial resources

INCREASE ENROLLMENT

- Enrollment Update (as of February 21, 2023)
 - Total 16,632 (-0.6% from prior year)
 - Freshmen 1,241 (+9.7% from prior year)
 - Transfers 1,050 (+16.4% from prior year)
 - Readmits 1,086 (-0.8% from prior year)
 - Non-Degree 1,8385 (+14.4% from prior year)
 - Continuing 11,450 (-4.8% from prior year)
- FTE 11,871 (-2.0% from prior year)
- Registration for 8W2 express session is ongoing until March 23 while registration for 7W1 express session ended:
 - 7W1 session 2/5/2023 3/21/2023 Enrollment: 429
 - 8W2 session 3/23/2023 5/23/2023 Enrollment: 1,146 and counting.

INCREASE ENROLLMENT

- AcMo 2.0
- Strategic Enrollment Management
 - Focus on retention initiatives
 - Increasing international student enrollment
 - Tutoring, SI, student intervention (Starfish)

RETENTION – B-UMLA Success Rates

- UMLA Programming housed in the BMCC Business Department
- Intentional Partnership between Departmental Faculty and Support Staff
- Intentional Partnership with Baruch College (BMCC/Baruch Business Academy)
- Funds from MacKenzie Scott donation, Robin Hood Foundation, and Tax-levy Funding
- B-UMLA students 71% Black/Hispanic and 67% Male
- Business majors 65% Black/Hispanic and 49% Male
- Impressive Results so far (2 Semesters, nearly 250 students)
 - Comparisons are B-UMLA students vs. all business majors
 - 92% vs. 82% course pass rates
 - 45% vs. 56% DFWI rate (negative and failing grades)
 - 80% vs. 52% next semester return rate (includes transfer and graduation)
 - 66% vs 30% next year return rate (includes transfer and graduation)

FINANCIAL PLAN UPDATE CUNY FUNDING FY 2023 AND 2024

- CUNY requested a \$2.7M savings target for FY 2023
- CUNY has requested an additional \$4.7M for FY 2024 increasing the total savings request to \$7.4M (\$2.7 + \$4.7)
- Concentration is on increasing revenue, increasing student collection rate and decrease in adjunct faculty cost
- Anticipated reductions in funding from New York City will require a revaluation of the target for FY 2024
