³ Among the options in Group B, students are strongly advised to take either ART 293 (Ancient Greece & Rome: Classical Art) or ART 292 (Renaissance & Baroque).

⁴ This course will be taken in the final semester (typically Spring semester) as an advanced writing seminar for a fully developed research paper in a discipline of the student's choosing.

⁵ Choose from the following disciplines (Art History [200 level or above]; Studio Art, Anthropology, Sociology, History, Ethnic and Race Studies (ASN, AFN, LAT, or ETH) [200 level or above]; English [300 level or above]) – courses must be 3-credits.

⁶ Students are strongly advised to take ART 113 (History of Graphic Design) to take 3 of the 6 credits for this requirement.

F. ARTICULATION AGREEMENT FOLLOW-UP PROCEDURES.

- 1. Procedures for reviewing, updating, modifying or terminating agreement: When either of the degree programs involved in this agreement undergoes a change, the agreement will be reviewed and revised accordingly by faculty from each institution's respective departments, selected by their Chairpersons.
- Procedures for evaluating agreement, i.e., tracking the number of students who transfer under the articulation agreement and their success:
 Each semester, Hunter College will provide BMCC with the following information: a) the number of BMCC students who applied to the program; b) the number of BMCC students who were accepted into the program; c) the number of BMCC students who enrolled and; d) the aggregate GPA of these enrolled students.
- Sending and receiving college procedures for publicizing agreement, e.g., college catalogs, transfer advisers, websites, etc.:
 This articulation agreement will be published on the BMCC website and Hunter College website.
 Transfer advisors at BMCC will promote this agreement with eligible students.
- 4. Campus Updates to Transfer Credit Rules:

Each college, will update their transfer rules in CUNYfirst based on the agreed upon course evaluation, as indicated in this document. When either college makes course revisions to courses included in the agreement, they will notify the other party.
