What Is a NYS Registered Apprenticeship Program?

A registered apprenticeship program is the process of learning a skilled trade through a combination of on-thejob training and related classroom instruction approved by the state. Apprentices are full time employees, who operate under the close supervision of a skilled worker on the job and take classroom instruction at night or on weekends. The length of training varies and for BMCC it's a one year program or 2,000 hours. Apprenticeships can also enable practitioners (job seekers) to gain a certification to practice in a regulated occupation. Most of their training is done while working for an employer who helps the apprentices learn their trade or profession, in exchange for their continued labor for an agreed period after they have achieved measurable competencies. Apprenticeship lengths vary significantly across sectors, professions, roles and cultures. At BMCC Adult Continuing Education and Workforce Development, we're committed to help career seekers earn and learn at the same time to achieve sustainability in growing fields and sectors. At the end of the program, apprentices not only have earned a fair wage, but have also received stackable credits towards their 2 year degree at BMCC. Apprenticeships have been utilized to meet the needs of America's skilled workforce for more than 80 years and we invite both job seekers and industry to come together to join our efforts.


