#### **FY 2025 BUDGET UPDATE**

- <u>Deficit</u> Target = -\$8.5M (LOSS)
- Fall Enrollment Target FTE 14,688 Projected to be met
- Spring to Fall Retention Target 59% Projected to be met
- Spring Targets:
  - Spring Enrollment Target FTE 13,707
  - Fall to Spring Retention Target 71%
- Fall to Fall (overall) Retention Target 63% (2% increase)
- One time PEG (NYC Program to Eliminate the Gap) \$3.5M partial restoration – increase to our reserve to absorb our future losses

#### **ACADEMIC AFFAIRS**

#### **Retention and Navigate:**

- 8W2 Pilot
  - Messaging went out to 2715 students via Brightspace and Navigate
  - As of 10/18, 2415 out of 2715 students opened the email.
- 1918+ students have downloaded the app from June to September 30
- A total of 4,958 students accessed Navigate360 desktop and mobile since June
