During the reporting period from July 1, 2025, through June 5, 2026, no alleged hazing incidents were reported at Borough of Manhattan Community College, and no individuals or organizations were found responsible for hazing violations.

Borough of Manhattan Community College and the City University of New York (“CUNY”) are committed to maintaining a safe and respectful environment in which all students may participate in clubs, organizations, and/or athletic teams without being subjected to hazing as a condition of entry or membership. Hazing is strictly prohibited and is inconsistent with CUNY policy and the Rules and Regulations for the Maintenance of Public Order Pursuant to Article 129-A of the New York State Education Law (the “Henderson Rules”). From July 1, 2025, through June 5, 2026, Borough of Manhattan Community College is pleased to report there have been no substantiated allegations of hazing involving student clubs, organizations or athletic teams established or recognized by the institution.
