Important Notice

Children are only allowed on campus as set forth in the below BMCC policy.

The college has an obligation to its students, faculty, staff, and visitors to conduct its operations and maintain its facilities in a manner consistent with its mission as an institution of higher education. For this reason, young children who are not registered in the childcare center should not be brought to the campus, and, of course, may not attend classes with their parent or guardian.

*There may be occasions when brief visits by children of students may be necessary. Children may visit college offices and facilities, **other than classrooms**, for limited periods of time when their parent or guardian is conducting routine business at the college. **Regular repeated visits by children are not permitted.***

In no case are children permitted in labs, shops, construction/repair sites, or other areas where potential hazards exist.

Children brought on campus must be directly supervised at all times by their parent or guardian.

At the BMCC Early Childhood Center, the staff work hard to meet students' needs. Whether the child is as young as 3 years old or as old as 12, there is a choice of the appropriate program available to match students' schedules.
