The Department of World Languages Literatures and Cultures at the Borough of Manhattan Community College is seeking ***adjunct/full-time substitute*** faculty to teach American Sign Language undergraduate courses for the 2026-2027 academic year.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

For Adjunct Assistant Professor, Associate Professor, or Full Professor:

Ph.D. degree in related ASL area(s) of experience or equivalent. At least 3 years of secondary and/or higher education teaching. Also required are the ability to teach successfully, demonstrated scholarship or achievement, and ability to cooperate with others for the good of the institution.

For Adjunct Lecturer:

Master's degree in related ASL area(s) of expertise, and/or active progress toward a Doctorate, or equivalent. At least 3 years of secondary and/or higher education teaching. Also required are the ability to teach successfully, and ability to cooperate with others for the good of the institution.

THE PREFERRED CANDIDATE WOULD HAVE:

- Evidence of excellence in ASL teaching at all levels of undergraduate language instruction, Deaf Studies courses, and Finger-Spelling courses.
- Ability to interact effectively with Deaf/ Hard of Hearing and hearing people, experience with service learning/practical applications of language preferred.
- Experience or familiarity with multiple teaching modalities, such as asynchronous, hybrid and in-person teaching.
- Extensive knowledge of Deaf Culture and the Deaf Community.
- Availability to teach evening/weekend classes if needed.
