 - Add the following sentences before the pre-requisites: This class is recommended for non-STEM majors. It does not satisfy the pre-requisites for MAT 056.
 - Remove the sentence after the pre-requisites starting "This course satisfies the..."
 - Change the cover sheet #5 so that the word Recitation replaces Lab. There should be six hours total, Lecture:4, Recitation:2.
 - Remove the last two words "and correlation" from the course description.
 - Submit a course revision for MAT 150 to explicitly state that students who pass MAT 150.5 cannot take MAT 150.
