## **Articulation Agreement**

## Between BMCC CUNY CareerPATH and the Paramedic Program at BMCC

A BMCC CUNY CareerPATH Emergency Medical Technician graduate who matriculates in the Paramedic program at CUNY Borough of Manhattan Community College will be eligible to receive (4) four credits for EMC 100 (Emergency Medical Care) if:

1. The student successfully completes the <u>206 contact hour</u> "Emergency Medical Care" segment of the Emergency Medical Technician - curriculum. Successful completion is to be determined by the instructor.

Participants who successfully complete emergency medical technician training can only apply the earned banked 4 credits elective (EMC 100) towards the Paramedic degree track program.

CCP staff will provide a letter supporting the transcript and copy signed by the program director will be submitted to the appropriate department chairperson.

Credits will be valid and applicable as long as the course is offered and/or recognized by the department.
