² Students complete semi-independent work and is required to meet weekly with two faculty advisors. In addition students must participate in seminars, visiting artists programs, groups critiques, discussions and exhibitions.

E. ARTICULATION AGREEMENT FOLLOW-UP PROCEDURES

1. *Procedures for reviewing, updating, modifying or terminating agreement:*

When either of the degree programs involved in this agreement undergoes a change, the agreement will be reviewed and revised accordingly by representatives from each institution's respective departments, as selected by their chairpersons/program directors.

2. *Procedures for evaluating agreement, i.e., tracking the number of students who transfer under the articulation agreement and their success:*

Each semester Alfred University will provide BMCC with the following information: a) the number of BMCC students who applied to the program; b) the number of BMCC students who were accepted into the program; c) the number of BMCC students who enrolled and; d) the aggregate GPA of these enrolled students.

3. *Sending and receiving college procedures for publicizing agreement, e.g., college catalogs, transfer advisers, websites, etc.:*

This articulation agreement will be publicizing on the BMCC website, and the Alfred University website. Transfer advisors at BMCC will promote this agreement with eligible students.

F. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION (E.G., FINANCIAL AID, TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIPS)

Scholarship Opportunities at Alfred University

Students who register for a minimum of 12-credits per semester are eligible for all federal and state grant programs for which they meet income eligibility requirement.

Alfred University Presidential Scholarship

- Available to transfer students with a cumulative grade point average of 3.3 or higher.
- School of Art & Design annual awards are \$10,500 per year for NY State residents and \$13,500 per year for non-residents. Renewal requires continuous full-time enrollment and a 3.0 cumulative grade point average.

Alfred University Dean's Scholarship

- Available to transfer students with a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher.
- School of Art & Design annual awards are \$9,000 for NY State residents and \$12,000 for non-residents. Renewal requires continuous full-time enrollment and a 2.75 cumulative grade point average.

Alfred University Art Portfolio Scholarship

- Available to transfer students in the School of Art & Design.
- Scholarship selection is on a competitive basis and made by a School of Art and Design faculty committee during portfolio review.
- Student receives \$10,500 per year for NY State residents and \$13,500 per year for non-residents. Renewal requires continuous full-time enrollment and a 2.75 cumulative grade point average after the first year students first year and a 3.0 for subsequent years.

Alfred University Jonathan Allen Scholarship

- Available to transfer students with a cumulative grade point average of 2.7 or higher.
- School of Art & Design annual awards are \$7,500 per year for NY State residents and \$10,500 per year for non-residents. Renewal requires continuous full-time enrollment and a 2.5 cumulative grade point average.

Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship

- Available to transfer students are members of Phi Theta Kappa.
- School of Art & Design annual awards are \$10,500 per year for NY State residents and \$13,500 per year for non-residents¹. Awards are renewable provided the student maintains continuous full-time enrollment and a 3.0 cumulative grade point average.
- File a completed application for admission and document your Phi Theta Kappa membership.

¹ Beginning fall 2018 this will be \$11,500 per year for NY State residents and \$14,500 for Non- NY State residents.
