- 2. The student successfully completes the <u>24 contact hour</u> "Treatment Services and Documentation" segment of the direct care counseling curriculum. Successful completion is to be determined by the instructor.
- 3. The student successfully completes the <u>24 contact hour</u> "Human Growth and Development" segment of the direct care counseling curriculum. Successful completion is to be determined by the instructor.
- 4. The student successfully completes the <u>24 contact hour</u> "Basic American Sign Language" segment of the direct care counseling curriculum. Successful completion is to be determined by the instructor.
- 5. The student successfully completes the <u>35 contact hour</u> "Approved Medication Administration Personnel" (AMAP) segment of the direct care counseling curriculum. Successful completion is to be determined by the instructor.
- 6. The student successfully completes the <u>21 contact hour</u> "Strategies for Crisis Intervention and Prevention" (SCIP) segment of the direct care counseling curriculum.
- 7. The student successfully completes the <u>7 contact hour</u> "FirstAid/CPR" segment of the direct care counseling curriculum. Successful completion is to be determined by the instructor.
- 8. The student successfully completes the <u>24 contact hour</u> "Professional Writing" segment of the direct counseling curriculum. Successful completion is to be determined by the instructor.
