AAS in Nursing to BS in Nursing

TRANSFERRING CREDITS FROM BOROUGH OF MANHATTAN COMMUNITY COLLEGE

Students completing the AAS in Nursing at Borough of Manhattan Community College (BMCC) may transfer 69 credits towards a BS in Nursing at NYU College of Nursing (NYUCN) allowing them to complete their NYU degree in less than two years if enrolled full-time.

NYUCN PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

NYUCN Bachelor of Science program with major in Nursing requires a total of 128 credits—44 credits of liberal arts courses, 20 credits of cognate (prerequisite) courses, 57 credits of nursing courses, and 6 credits of restricted electives. Please see the attached Nursing Progression Form.

By following BMCC's AAS in Nursing Curriculum, students can transfer a total of 69 credits to NYUCN's Nursing Program: 18 credits towards the Liberal Arts Requirements (ENG 101, MAT 104, PSY 100, SOC 100, ENG 201, and SPE 100), 14 credits towards the Cognate (Prerequisite) Requirements (CHE 121, BIO 425, BIO 426, BIO 420, and PSY 240), and 33 credits towards the Nursing Requirements (NUR 112, NUR 211, NUR 313, NUR 411, and NUR 415).

BMCC students who transfer under this agreement must complete the following courses at NYU:

Cognate (Prerequisite) Requirements:

Leadership & Management in Nursing
Restricted Nursing Elective (2 courses)

- Although NYUCN allocates 4 credits for each required liberal arts course, BMCC 3 credit courses satisfy the content requirement. Applicants may use the extra credit from each of these courses to transfer any liberal arts courses in order to reach the credit total for the program.
- Courses transferring to NYUCN must have a grade of “C” or better.
- Performance, workshop, studio, physical education, and sports courses are **not** transferrable.
- Courses taken at BMCC need not be repeated at NYU.
- Applicants from 2-year colleges are eligible to transfer a maximum of 72 credits towards the requirements needed for a bachelor’s degree.

FOR MORE INFORMATION

This transfer agreement is intended to serve as a guide for students who want to transfer from BMCC to NYUCN. Because each student’s academic record is different, the NYUCN Office of Student Affairs and Admissions (OSAA) is happy to provide you with guidance and information about your individual transfer situation.
