ST. JOHN'S UNIVERSITY BOROUGH OF MANHATTAN COMMUNITY COLLEGE

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

This Agreement is between St. John's University, New York ("St. John's" or "the University"), an institution of higher education formed and existing under the New York Education Law, and Borough of Manhattan Community College formed and existing under the State of New York Education Law, an institution of higher education, and is dated October 21, 2015.

WHEREAS, Borough of Manhattan Community College desires to provide for the preferential transfer admission of well-qualified Borough of Manhattan Community College students to St. John's University, and

WHEREAS, in support of its academic mission, St. John's University desires to accept as transfer students such well-qualified Borough of Manhattan Community College enrollees; and

WHEREAS, the intent of this Agreement is to facilitate the smooth transfer and transition of Borough of Manhattan Community College students to the University, the successful implementation of the Agreement depends upon communication of its contents to all involved participants, and assumption of responsibility by both institutions for such communication.

NOW THEREFORE, Borough of Manhattan Community College and St. John's University agree as follows for the mutual covenants contained in this agreement and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and adequacy of which are hereby acknowledged:

General Terms

This Agreement shall automatically renew on an annual basis. This Agreement will be reviewed by both institutions every other year and updated or terminated as determined by either party on six months' prior, written notice; however, all students currently enrolled in the program at Borough of Manhattan Community College will be permitted to complete their degree and transfer to St. John's University before final phase out of this Agreement occurs.

Because the efforts of the schools in launching and maintaining this program will not bear fruit unless Borough of Manhattan Community College's current and prospective students are made aware of it, St. John's and Borough of Manhattan Community College will make joint efforts to publicize the program internally and externally. Each School must approve any information or statements about the program, whether published only in one School's materials (including admissions information, student bulletins, course guides, etc.) or otherwise.

Each party warrants that it shall not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national or ethnic origin, religion, age, gender, sex, marital status, disability or any other protected class in referring, advising or directing students in connection with this Agreement.

AGREEMENT FOLLOW-UP PROCEDURES

- Procedures for reviewing, updating, modifying or terminating agreement:

 When either of the degree programs involved in this agreement undergoes a change, the agreement will be reviewed and revised accordingly by faculty from each institution's respective departments or programs, selected by their Chairpersons and program directors.
- Procedures for evaluating agreement (i.e., tracking the number of students who transfer under the articulation agreement and their success):

 Each year St. John's University will provide Borough of Manhattan Community College the following information: a) the number of Borough of Manhattan Community College graduates who applied to the program; b) the number of Borough of Manhattan Community College students who were accepted into the program; c) and the number of Borough of Manhattan Community College students who enrolled; d) the aggregate GPA of these enrolled students at St. John's University.
- Sending and receiving college procedures for publicizing agreement (e.g., college catalogs, transfer advisers, websites, etc.):

 This articulation agreement will be publicized on the Borough of Manhattan Community College's website and St. John's University's website.

The University will:

- evaluate all applications from Borough of Manhattan Community College students, and assess their candidacy. Borough of Manhattan Community College students must satisfy all of the admission requirements of St. John's University. Borough of Manhattan Community College students who are unable to satisfy an admission requirement may be considered by the University on a case by case basis.
- designate an academic advisor from each School or College for Borough of Manhattan Community College students transferring to the University.
- conduct an orientation and registration program specific for Borough of Manhattan Community College students transferring to the University.
- provide regular, on-site advising sessions on the Borough of Manhattan Community College's campus for students interested in transferring to the University.
- have faculty continue to work with Borough of Manhattan Community College's chair or designee in reviewing additional courses for transferability.
- provide eligible students transferring to the University with academic scholarships upon their acceptance. Transfer scholarship eligibility requirements can be found at http://www.stjohns.edu/admission-aid/scholarships/transfer-scholarships.

BOROUGH OF MANHATTAN COMMUNITY COLLEGE will:

- publicize this Agreement to students, faculty and professional staff in campus publications.
- have advisors inform interested students of this opportunity and have transfer advisors at Borough Manhattan Community College promote this agreement with eligible students.
- obtain consent from its students in order to provide a list of graduates upon request.
- provide a list of majors upon request.
- organize a "St. John's Day" for students to meet with advisors on the Borough of Manhattan Community College campus.
- assure that brochures and other printed materials are distributed to its transfer office, advisement center and academic departments.
- advertise any special programs or events the University is offering on Borough of Manhattan Community College's campus.

Transfer Guidelines

Attached as Exhibit A are the guidelines governing the transfer of credits from Borough of Manhattan Community College to the University (the "Transfer Guidelines"). The University and Borough of Manhattan Community College also will meet from time to time to identify any difficulties in the program, evaluate course sequence and content to facilitate transfers with minimal academic disruptions, and update the Transfer Guidelines, with particular attention to course equivalencies (i.e. Borough of Manhattan Community College classes for which students will receive University credits). The University reserves the right in its academic discretion to modify or amend programs, as it would with its four-year students, whenever it deems appropriate.
