CUNY's Revised Tobacco Policy

The Board of Trustees of The City University of New York have adopted a revised tobacco policy, effective no later than September 4, 2012, prohibiting **(i) the use of tobacco on all grounds and facilities under CUNY jurisdiction, including indoor locations and outdoor locations such as playing fields; entrances and exits to buildings; and parking lots;** (ii) tobacco industry promotions, advertising, marketing, and distribution of marketing materials on campus properties; and (iii) tobacco industry sponsorship of athletic events and athletes.

Technology Committee Report March 2012

1 E-Learning reports that BMCC has a total of 913 (30%) active Blackboard sections for the Spring 2012 semester. Distribution is as follows:

45 online courses (981-984 section numbers)

36 hybrid courses (985-989 section numbers)

832 web-enhanced courses - all other BB sections

Total number of courses, both online and face-to-face, for Spring 2012 - 2995

3. HDMI cables are being installed as the second source to the ceiling mounted projectors at Chambers Street. Laptops with HDMI output can connect to the projectors with one cable. 4. Microsoft Office Suite will be loaded onto cyber café workstations to improve access to technology for students.
