٧. STANDING COMMITTEE REPORTS

- A. The Campus Facilities and Security Committee Chair Vice President Scott Anderson presented a report on the status of Recovery and Repairs to the College after Hurricane Sandy.
 - 1. The Committee toured the campus to view the damage, particular with regard to damage to electrical and mechanical systems.
 - 2. We are operating on 4/5 of our power.
 - 3. One mechanical engineering room was destroyed.
 - 4. There will be more heat soon, particularly on the First Floor South.

- 5. Collateral damage is appearing.
 - a. Tiles on the first floor will need to be replaced.
 - b. The theatres will need new hydraulic systems.
 - c. We lost eight vehicles.
- 6. Last Tuesday, there were two evacuations.
 - a. An unmarked electrical conduit had its contents damaged by sea water.
 - b. This damage caused sparks and the water boiled away, giving the appearance of a steam leak.
 - c. This conduit turns out to be a redundant line and will be patched later.
- 7. A full assessment will be needed for the perimeter.
- 8. Vice President Anderson thanked all the workers who helped to clean up the damage.
